### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:**

Pursuant to Chapter 594 of the 2005 Laws of Maryland, the public safety surcharge is required adjusted each fiscal year for inflation pursuant to the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Cons (CPI-U). The CPI-U for April 2017 shows an increase of 2.2% and results in a surcharge increase \$54 above the Fiscal Year 2017 public safety surcharge of \$2,461 for permits issued insid Developed Tier and inside an area included in a certain basic plan or conceptual site plan. increase in the CPI-U results in a surcharge increase of \$162 above the Fiscal Year 2017 public surcharge of \$7,379 for permits issued for all other buildings.

For Fiscal Year 2018, the public safety surcharge shall be \$2,515 for permits issued for constructed inside the Developed Tier, as defined by the Maryland - National Capital Park and Pla Commission in the Prince George's County Approved General Plan, and for construction in ar included in a basic plan or conceptual site plan that abuts an existing or planned mass trans station site operated by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority and complies wit requirements of any sector plan, master plan or overlay zone approved by the Prince George's (District Council. The public safety surcharge for Fiscal Year 2018 shall be \$7,541 for all buildings.

NOTE: This Resolution is retroactively effective to 7/1/2017.
