BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This legislation is waiving the certain requirements for procurements. Pursuant to Sections 10A-112, 10A-113, 10A-114 and 10A-162 of the Prince George's County Code, a waiver is required if the Purchasing Agent determines that there are insufficient responsible County-Based Small Businesses (CBSB) to fulfill certain procurement requirements. The Prince George's County Code requires approval of the waiver by Council Resolution and the concurrence of the County Executive. This legislation will waive the certified CBSB requirements and approve the issuance of non-competitive awards, extension of contracts and solicitations for the procurement of services as required pursuant to Section 10A-162 of the Prince George's County Code.
