WHEREAS, the	he Councils jointly endorsed in concept the January 1994 Working Group		
Report spending affordability process; and			
WHEREAS, b	ooth Councils endorsed the utilization of the spending affordability process		
beginning with the formulation of the Fiscal Year 1996 budget; and			

WHEREAS, the Spending Affordability Working Group, consisting of the staffs of the Montgomery and Prince George's County Councils and both County Executive's offices, make certain recommendations on the WSSC Fiscal Year 2019 Operating and Capital Budgets; and

3	percentage of water and sewer increase; new debt; debt service and operating expenditures;
