REPORT: Favorable, 4-1 In Favor: Council Members Glaros, Harrison, Taveras, and Turner. Oppose: Lehman.

CB-114-2017 is a Bill to amend the Chief Liquor Inspector, the Deputy Chief Liquor Inspector, Liquor Inspectors, Personnel Analysis and Personnel Aide series. The changes are a result of an organizational study done for the Board of License Commissioners. The study revealed that the Chief and Deputy Liquor Inspectors should be assigned to a higher grade and classified as exempt status positions. The Liquor Inspectors will become part of the classified service. In addition, based on the results of the study, the Personnel Analyst and the Personnel Aide class series will reflect a change in the class series titles.

Valarie Farrar, Office of Human Resources Management provided the Committee with an overview of CB-114-2017.

Questions were raised about the current liquor inspectors as it related to the classified service and the Committee was informed that the current inspectors would be appointed to similar positions with the classified service.

The Office of Law verbally reported CB-114-2017 to be in proper legislative from with no legal impediments to its enactment.

The Office of Audits and Investigations reports that the enactment of CB-114-2017 will have an adverse fiscal impact of \$134,973 for FY' 2018.

After discussion, the Public Safety and Fiscal Management Committee voted CB-114-2017 out favorably, 4-1.
