(b) TABLE OF USES I.

66 Notwithstanding the requirements of Part 12 of this Subtitle, a property is permitted to have two (2) pole mounted freestanding signs with each sign having a maximum height of fifty (50) feet and a maximum sign area of four hundred (400) square feet; and one (1) monument sign having a maximum height of ten (10) feet and a maximum sign area of one hundred and fifty (150) square feet, provided the site:

(A) consists of at least ten (10) acres;

(B) is located within an Enterprise Zone;

(C) is adjacent to two (2) roadways with a classification of arterial or higher;

(D) contains an Integrated Shopping Center with a minimum of 100,000 square feet of total floor area which was originally constructed prior to January 1, 1985;

(E) contains at least one (1) tenant with a minimum of 20,000 square feet of floor area; and

(F) is not located within a half-mile radius from a planned or constructed Purple Line Light Rail Station.

1 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect on the
