REPORT: Favorable, 5-0 (In Favor: Council Members Glaros, Harrison, Lehman, Taveras, and Turner.)

The Public Safety and Fiscal Management Committee convened on October 26, 2017 to interview nominees for the Spending Affordability Committee for Prince George's County. The Committee makes recommendations to the County Executive, the County Council and the Office of Management and Budget concerning spending affordability and guides the government in preparation, review and adoption of the County's current expense budget. The Committee also recommends ways to improve the County's budgetary procedures and policies.

The nominees are as follows:

- Ms. Terri Bacote-Charles, a resident of Bowie, Maryland, is currently Vice President for Administrative and Financial Services at Prince George's Community College. Ms. Bacote-Charles has a long career serving the residents of Prince George's County and the State of Maryland, having recently served as Director and Deputy Director Office of Management and Budget. Prior to that Ms. Bacote-Charles worked as a Senior Budget Analyst for the Prince George's County Public Schools. She holds a B.A. and a M.A. Degree.
- Mr. Robert Hagans, Jr., a resident of Mitchellville, Maryland, is a senior executive with over 40 years of progressive financial, administrative, operational and government experience. Most recently he served as Chief Financial Officer for NACO. Mr. Hagans served as Chief Financial Officer at the American Association for Retired Persons. He also served as Director of Finance for Prince George's County. He holds both a B.A. and a MBA Degree. Mr. Hagans is being designated as Chair of this Committee.
- Mr. Henry Mosley, a resident of Upper Marlboro, Maryland, serves as CFO of Events DC, the official convention and sports authority for the District of Columbia. As CFO, his primary responsibilities include oversight of the budgetary functions, accounting, treasury, procurement and information technology. Prior to this position he was Associate Chief Financial Officer for the District of Columbia Government. Mr. Mosley holds both a B.S. and a M.S. Degree.

The Committee allowed each nominee to speak of their qualifications for the position on the Spending Affordability Committee. Each nominee expressed a keen interest in serving Prince George's County.

After discussion, the Public Safety and Fiscal Management Committee voted the nomination of all candidates out favorably, 5-0.
