WHEREAS	, pursuant to Charter Section 402, the County Executive's powers, duties, and
responsibilities in	aclude, but shall not be limited to signing or causing to be signed on the
County's behalf a	all contracts including contracts for goods and services; and
WHEREAS	, pursuant to County Code Section 21-119.01, the Council made a statement of
policy and legisla	tive findings that the regular, uninterrupted, and efficient removal of refuse
from residences v	within the County is necessary to prevent nuisances, contagious diseases and
vermin; the need	to provide efficient, uninterrupted refuse collection service exists throughout
the County; and to ensure the continuity of efficient refuse collection services and thereby to	
protect and promote the public safety, health, comfort and welfare; and	
WHEREAS	, pursuant to County Code Section 21-119.01, the Council determined it was
necessary 1) to provide for limitations on the number of residences which may be served by any	
one contractor; 2) to provide for the bidding, award, and extension of contracts for the provision	
of refuse collection services; and 3) to authorize the Purchasing Agent to extend or rebid refuse	
collection contrac	ets in appropriate circumstances; and

WHEREAS for many years the residents of Prince George's County have become accustomed to twice a week refuse collection; and

WHEREAS, the recent change to once a week refuse collection has created hardship which
