BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This legislation is required to comply with Section 16-231 of the Prince George's County Code provides that any amendment to a pension plan that binds the County to finance or make contribumust be approved by a legislative act of the County Council.

This legislation will amend the Prince George's County Deputy Sheriff's Pension Plan to approve a line of duty death benefit for the surviving spouse of a Deputy Sherriff who dies in the line of duty.
