BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

Section 25-303 of the Land Use Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, authorizes municipal corporations to enact certain municipal ordinances that impose stricter requirements for fences in their respective jurisdictions, so long as the municipal ordinance is transmitted to the District Council for review and approval by resolution. This Resolution approves College Park Ordinance 17-O-1, enacted by the Mayor and Council of the City of College Park on November 28, 2017, concerning fences.
