




#### Lack of Access to Counsel











Vera released an evaluation in 2017 – proved the success of the model


## NYIFUP evaluation: Representation Matters!



The percentage of successful cases for unrepresented people in NYC before NYIFUP. 48%

People who win their legal case gain or maintain work authorization, manifesting in **\$2.7 million** in annual projected tax revenues.






