CB-003-2018 DR-1 Swimming Pool Lifeguard Qualifications

Legislative Summary

CB-003-2018 seeks to amend the qualifications for swimming pool lifeguards in Prince George's County to be in conformity with State Law.

Background/Current Law

Section 5-223 of the Prince George's County Code states, "Public swimming pool lifeguards must be sixteen (16) years of age or older, and hold a valid certificate approved by the County Health Officer".

Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 10.17.01 Public Swimming Pools and Spas defines a lifeguard as an individual who is 15 years old or older, who meets certain criteria as stated within the regulation.
