## **REPORT:**

Committee Vote: Favorable with Amendments, 4-0, (In favor: Council Members Davis, Franklin, Harrison and Lehman).

The Legislative Officer provided an overview of CR-23-2018. The resolution authorizes the creation of a Food truck Hub at Iverson Mall located at 3737 Branch Avenue, Temple Hills, Maryland.

The Legislative Officer explained that Iverson Mall does not meet the Food Truck Hub location criteria. Therefore, it requires approval via County Council resolution to create a Food Truck Hub location that is outside of the locations authorized in Section 5-189.01 of the County Code. Iverson Mall is not under operation or control of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, nor is the area located within a quarter mile radius of the station entrance of any Metro or MARC station.

Iverson Mall must still satisfy the requirements for the Food Truck Hub License and remain subject to approval by the Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement (DPIE). Authorization by the Council is subject to Iverson Mall satisfying these requirements.

The Resolution title on page 1, Line 3 and on page 2, line 5 was modified with the deletion of the following language, "Town of Temple Hills."

The public hearing was held on May 1, 2018.

The Committee voted favorable as amended on CR-23-2018.
