12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
13	Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional

Sec. 27-405.01. Class 3 fills.

(a) A Class 3 fill may be permitted as a temporary Special Exception, subject to the following:

(1) Within one hundred and twenty (120) days after an application for a Class 3 fill is accepted by the Planning Board, the Zoning Hearing Examiner shall conduct a public hearing. The Zoning Hearing Examiner's written decision on an application shall be issued within thirty (30) days after the public hearing. Where the District Council makes the final decision, the Council's final order shall be issued within sixty (60) days of the Examiner's decision.

(2) Initially, a Special Exception for a new Class 3 fill shall be valid for five (5) years, unless the District Council grants some lesser time period. Extensions of specific periods may be granted not to exceed five (5) years. At least one [hundred and eighty (180) days] calendar year prior to the expiration of a Special Exception for a Class 3 fill, a request for an extension shall be filed with the Zoning Hearing Examiner. The applicant shall also send a copy of the request, in accordance with the informational mailing requirements of Section 27-125.01, to all adjoining property owners and civic associations. The Examiner shall conduct a public hearing in accordance with all requirements and procedures for the initial application. The filing fee for the extension shall be one-half the amount of the fee for a new application.

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1	SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five
