**RESOLUTION**

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The approval of the Fiscal Year 2019 Operating and Capital Budgets of the Washington  
3 Suburban Sanitary Commission and the Recommendation of Water and Sewer Rates and  
4 Ad Valorem Tax Levies for Fiscal Year 2019

5 For the purpose of adopting the Fiscal Year 2019 Operating and Capital Budgets of the  
6 Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission and the recommended Water and Sewer Rates and  
7 Ad Valorem Tax Levies for Fiscal Year 2019.

8 WHEREAS, Section 17-202 of the Public Utilities Article, Annotated Code of Maryland  
9 establishes a procedure for the preparation, review and approval of the annual capital and  
10 operating budgets of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission, and further provides for  
11 recommendations by the Montgomery and Prince George's County Councils regarding the rates  
12 for water consumption and sewer usage charges and the ad valorem tax levies of the  
13 Commission; and

14 WHEREAS, on March 1, 2018, the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission submitted  
15 to the County Executives of Montgomery and Prince George's Counties its proposed capital and  
16 operating budgets for Fiscal Year 2019; and

17 WHEREAS, the Commission forwarded to the County Executives of both Counties the  
18 record of the public hearings held by the Commission regarding its budget proposal; and

19 WHEREAS, the County Executives of Montgomery and Prince George's Counties  
20 transmitted their recommendations on the Commission's proposed budget, including the record  
21 of the public hearings held by the Commission, to the respective County Councils; and

22 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council, upon due public notice, held a public

hearing on the Commission's proposed budget on April 10, 2018, at which interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard by the Prince George's County Council; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council, following review of said budgets, approved, proposed additions to, deletions from, increases and decreases from items contained in the proposed budgets and transmitted these proposed changes to the Montgomery County Council by letter dated May 9, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council received on May 9, 2018, from the Montgomery County Council its approved proposed additions to, deletions from, and increases and decreases from items in the Commission's proposed budgets; and

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2018, the Montgomery and Prince George's County Councils jointly reviewed the respective proposed additions to, deletions from, and increases and decreases regarding items in said submitted capital and operating budgets and further considered all proposed changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the following amounts and positions, or as much thereof as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes designated, are hereby approved for the budget of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2019:

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1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in implementing the above operating budget, the  
 2 Commission shall establish its work program priorities within the dollar and work-year levels  
 3 approved herein; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in adopting its Fiscal Year 2019 Operating  
 5 Budget, the Counties and the Commission recognize that although total operating debt service is  
 6 \$294,348,640 and equals 37.7% of the total operating budget, water and sewer operating debt  
 7 service, the portion of debt service supported by water and sewer rate revenues is \$277,060,690  
 8 or 36.3% of the water and sewer operating budget; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Prince George's County Council joins with the  
 10 Montgomery County Council in recommending to the Washington Suburban Sanitary  
 11 Commission the following:

- 12 1. Average rate increase for Water Consumption and Sewer Usage charge: 4.5%.
- 13 2. The Water and Sewer Usage charges will be based on a water production rate of  
 14 164.0 million gallons per day; and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any supplements to the Washington Suburban  
 16 Sanitary Commission's Approved Fiscal Year 2019 budget shall be in accordance with the  
 17 provisions of Section 17-202 of the Public Utilities Article, Annotated Code of Maryland; and

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission shall:

- 19 1. Obtain the approval of both County Councils before increasing operating  
 20 expenditures above \$781,580,799.
- 21 2. Obtain the County Councils' approval prior to making any transfer of funds  
 22 from any of the approved expenditure categories within the operating and  
 23 capital budgets in excess of five percent (5%) of the approved amounts. The  
 24 amount approved for debt service is excluded from this transfer authority.
- 25 3. Furnish monthly status reports to each County Council and County Executive  
 26 as to the fiscal and budgetary activities of the Commission pursuant to the  
 27 Approved Operating and Capital Budgets, commencing with the end of the first  
 28 quarter of the fiscal year. These reports shall be submitted not more than 45  
 29 calendar days after the close of each month.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Approved Washington Suburban Sanitary  
 31 Commission FY 2019 Water and Sewer Rate Schedule (Appendix C), Account

1 Maintenance Fees and Charges (Appendix D), and Infrastructure Investment Fees  
2 (Appendix E) are hereby approved, attached and incorporated by reference; and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission may find it necessary from time to  
4 time or on an emergency basis to adopt further orders or resolutions in connection with its Fiscal  
5 Year 2019 Budget and/or the water and sewer use rates to be effective July 1, 2018 pursuant to  
6 its authority under the Laws of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District, Public Utilities  
7 Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.
