Committee Vote: 7-1. In favor: Council Members Glaros, Davis, Franklin, Patterson, Taveras, Toles and Turner; Opposed: Council Member Lehman. Absent: Council Member Harrison

The County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on Monday, July 2, 2018, to consider CB-040-2018, legislation styled as a proposed Charter Amendment as to Section 505 of the Prince George's County Charter. As explained by staff of the Legislative Branch, this bill proposes certain recommended amendments to the County Charter to guard against repeated temporary administrative appointments as Directors of County agencies and departments. Although the matter was initially held, upon suggestion by Council Member Franklin, the Committee reconsidered its prior notion to delay action on the proposed legislation by the Committee.

After discussion by members as to the relevant underpinnings of the proposed Charter Amendment, the Committee voted 7—1 for a favorable recommendation and report as to CB-40-2018 (DR-1).
