## **REPORT:**

Committee Vote: 8-0. In favor: Council Members Glaros, Davis, Franklin, Lehman, Patterson, Taveras, Toles and Turner. Absent: Council Member Harrison

The County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on Monday, July 2, 2018, to consider CB-38-2018, legislation styled as a proposed Charter Amendment as to Section 308 of the Prince George's County Charter. As explained by staff of the Legislative Branch, this bill proposes certain recommended amendments to the County Charter, as recommended by the 2017-18 Charter Review Commission convened in accordance with law. As proposed, this legislation will clarify that persons elected as members of the County Council serve in a full-time position capacity for the purpose of determining compensation.

After discussion by members as to the relevant underpinnings of the proposed Charter Amendment legislation, the Committee further voted 8—0 (Absent: Council Member Harrison) for a favorable recommendation as to CB-38-2018 (DR-1).
