WHEREA	S, during the Fiscal Year 1994 Bi-County budget process the Montgomery and	
Prince George's	County Councils established a Bi-County Working Group to recommend	
changes that wo	uld control the growth of debt and maintain future rate increases at WSSC close	
to the level of in	flation; and	
WHEREA	S, the Working Group's January 1994 Report recommended the establishment of	
a spending affor	dability process; and	
WHEREA	S, the Prince George's County Council endorsed the entire Working Group's	
report through th	ne adoption of CR-12-1994 and the Montgomery County Council endorsed part	
of the report's re	commendations through Resolution #12-1558; and	
WHEREA	S, the Councils jointly endorsed in concept the January 1994 Working Group	
Report spending	affordability process; and	
WHEREA	S, both Councils endorsed the utilization of the spending affordability process	
beginning with t	he formulation of the Fiscal Year 1996 budget; and	
WHEREA	S, the Spending Affordability Working Group, consisting of the staffs of the	
Montgomery and	d Prince George's County Councils and both County Executive's offices, make	
certain recomme	endations on the WSSC Fiscal Year 2020 Operating and Capital Budgets; and	

1	WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council and the Montgomery Council have	
2	reviewed the information compiled by the staff relating to spending control limits on the	
3	percentage of water and sewer increase; new debt; debt service and operating expenditures;	
4	WHEREAS, on October 11, 2018, the Transportation, Housing and Environment	
5	Committee discussed the spending control limits for WSSC's FY 2020 Capital and Operating	
6	Budgets and voted on recommendations to the Council.	
7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's	
8	County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Council hereby endorses the following	
9	spending control limits for the Fiscal Year 2020 Water and Sewer Operating and Capital Budget

11	Maximum Average Rate Increase: 5%	
12	New Water and Sewer Debt: \$385,527,000	
13	Water and Sewer Debt Service: \$306,350,000	
14	Total Water and Sewer Operating Expense: \$798,953,000
