BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This bill proposes an amendment to Section 603 of the Charter of Prince George's County to provide that the Council may not authorize the County Purchasing Agent to negotiate extensions of existing contracts for garbage and refuse collection, without competitive bidding.
