The bill deletes the requirement that a special exception be approved prior to operation. Instead, the applicant must file a Site Plan with its building permit application. This type of review raises the following questions:

- 1. What if anything can be done if DPIE questions the information shown on the Site Plan? As drafted there doesn't appear to be any ability to amend/reject the information.
- 2. Current law included many other public safety requirements such as volume of traffic expected from the use, location of haul routes, a 200 foot access driveway to the site, and a referral to various county and state agencies before the use can be approved (see section 27-343.02 of the zoning ordinances). Is the sponsor amenable to adding any of these?
