SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,					
Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional					
District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Sections 27-134 and 135 of the Zoning					
Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's					
County Code, be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

5	Sec. 27-134. Notice of decision.					
6	The <u>notice of final</u> decision, findings, conclusions, and votes of the Council in any zoning case					
7	shall be served upon all persons of record and any public agency processing the application. For					
8	purposes of this Code, reconsideration of the final decision shall be filed within thirty (30) days					
9	after the date of service of the Notice of Final Decision by the Clerk of the Council.					
10	Sec. 27-135 Reconsideration and amendment of decisions.					
11	(a) Reconsiderations and site plan amendments for Special Exceptions shall be as provided					
12	for in Part 4. All others are governed by this Section (except Zoning Ordinance text					
13	amendments).					
14	(b) Once a final decision has been made by the District Council, the decision may be					
15	reconsidered upon a written request filed by either the applicant or other person of record within					
16	thirty (30) days [of the final decision] after the date of service of the Notice of Final Decision by					
17	the Clerk of the Council if, based on the written request, the Council finds that there may have					
18	been an error in reaching the final decision that was caused by fraud, surprise, mistake, or					
19	inadvertence. The person of record filing the request for reconsideration shall, upon filing the					
20	request, send a copy to all other persons of record.					
21	(1) If the District Council determines there may be grounds for reconsideration of their final					
22	decision, the Clerk of the Council shall schedule an evidentiary hearing on the request.					
23	(2) After hearing, the District Council shall first vote to reconsider their final decision and, if an					
24	affirmative motion is adopted, vote on a new decision.
