WHEREAS, a	an application for financial assistance impose certain obligations upon the
applicant, which in	cludes a local share of the costs for certain projects and/or programs; and
WHEREAS, t	he United States Department of Transportation, in accordance with the
provisions of Title	VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, requires an application for assistance
under the Federal T	Fransit Act to give assurance that it will comply with the Title VI of the Civil
Rights Act of 1964	and the United States Department of Transportation requirements thereunder

WHEREAS, Prince George's County Department of Public Works and Transportation will be submitting an application to the Maryland Transit Administration for financial assistance under the SSTAP to support the County's mass transportation program; and

WHEREAS, the County: (1) aims to utilize minority business enterprises to the fullest

1 extent possible in connection with the program and/or projects listed in the County's application; 2 and (2) shall establish and administer procedures to ensure that minority businesses have the 3 maximum construction, supplies, equipment, consultant and other service contracts; and WHEREAS, as a condition of awarding transportation funding through the SSTAP, the 4 5 Maryland Transit Administration requires the governing body of Prince George's County, by 6 resolution, to authorize the filing of the aforesaid application. 7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the filing of the aforesaid application for Fiscal Year 2020 be endorsed. 8 9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Prince George's County Executive is hereby requesting to endorse this Resolution, thereby indicating approval thereof. 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolutions shall be sent to the Maryland 12 Transit Administration of the Maryland Department of Transportation.
