RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Public Works Week 2019

3 For the purpose of expressing Prince George’s County’s support for declaring the week of May
4 19 – May 25, 2019 as Public Works Week in Prince George’s County.

5 WHEREAS, Public Works professionals focus on infrastructure, facilities and services that
6 are of vital importance to sustainable and resilient communities and to the public health, high
7 quality of life and well-being of the people of Prince George’s County; and

8 WHEREAS, these infrastructure, facilities and services could not be provided without the
9 dedicated efforts of Public Works professionals, who are engineers, managers and employees at
10 all levels of government and the private sector, who are responsible for rebuilding, improving
11 and protecting our nation’s transportation, water supply, water treatment and solid waste
12 systems, public buildings, and other structures and facilities essential for our citizens; and

13 WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the residents, civic leaders and children in Prince
14 George’s County, to gain knowledge of and to maintain a progressive interest and understanding
15 of the importance of public works and public works programs in their respective communities;

17 WHEREAS, this year marks the 59th annual National Public Works Week, celebrating its
18 theme “It Starts Here,” which is sponsored by the American Public Works Association,

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of Prince George's
20 County, Maryland, joined by the Prince George’s County Executive, hereby supports and
21 proclaims this week of May 19 – May 25 as Public Works Week in Prince George’s County, and
22 asks everyone to join us in recognizing and reaffirming the contributions of Public Works

1 professionals in Prince George’s County and throughout the State of Maryland.

2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all residents of the County are encouraged to join
3 representatives of the American Public Works Association and government agencies in activities,
4 events and ceremonies designed to pay tribute to Public Work professionals, engineers, managers
5 and employees and to recognize the substantial contributions they make to protect our national
6 health, safety, and quality of life.
