BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This legislation is required pursuant to Section 819 of the Prince George's County Charter. Section 819 requires multi-year contracts exceeding an aggregate of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) must be approved by resolution of the County Council upon notice and public hearing. This resolution will approve a multi-year Financing Agreement to fund the County's 2019 capital equipment requirements of Sixteen Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$16,500,000).

The fiscal impact on the County for capital equipment and vehicle purchases will be negative. Debt service is the sole responsibility of the County.
