**BILL**

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Food Service Manager Certification Issuance Time Period

3 For the purpose of revising the food service manager certification time period.

4 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

5 SUBTITLE 12. HEALTH.

6 Section 12-114.01,

7 The Prince George's County Code

8 (2015 Edition; 2018 Supplement).

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,  
10 Maryland, that Section 12-114.01 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby  
11 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

12 **SUBTITLE 12. HEALTH.**

13 **DIVISION 2. FOOD SERVICE FACILITIES.**

14 **SUBDIVISION 3. PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS.**

15 **Sec. 12-114.01. Food Service Manager Certification.**

17 (c) A food service manager certificate shall be issued in the name of an individual only[,]  
18 and shall be valid for [a period of three (3) years from completion of the certification training or  
19 passage of the examination.] the period of the certification.

21 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby

1 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,  
2 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of  
3 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining  
4 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this  
5 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such  
6 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,  
7 or section.

8 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)  
9 calendar days after it becomes law.
