The Office of Law has reviewed the above referenced bill as it was presented on April 2, 2019, and finds it to be in proper legislative form. We see no legal impediments to its enactment. Additionally, we recommend making the same change in Sec. 1-106.03(d) of the Prince George's County Code.

Sec. 1-106.03. - Time and occasions for display.

(d) Particular days of display. The flag should be displayed on all days, especially on New Year's Day, January 1; Inauguration Day, January 20; Lincoln's Birthday, February 12; Washington's Birthday, third Monday in February; Easter Sunday (variable); Mother's Day, second Sunday in May; Armed Forces Day, third Saturday in May; Memorial Day (half-staff until noon), the last Monday in May; Flag Day, June 14; Independence Day, July 4; Labor Day, first Monday in September; Constitution Day, September 17; [Columbus Day] Native American Day, second Monday in October; Navy Day, October 27; Veterans Day, November 11; Thanksgiving Day, fourth Thursday in November; Christmas Day, December 25; and such other days as may be proclaimed by the President of the United States; the birthdays of States (date of admission); and on State holidays.
