## **RESOLUTION**

## A RESOLUTION concerning

Preparation of a Countywide Sectional Map Amendment and approval of Goals, Concepts, and Guidelines; and Public Participation Program

For the purpose of initiating an amendment to the Zoning Map for that portion of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland; and approving Goals, Concepts, and Guidelines; and a Public Participation Program in order to apply the zoning classifications set forth in the approved replacement Zoning Ordinance, CB-013-2018, enacted by the Council on October 23, 2018 <u>and if amended during the Countywide Sectional Map</u> <u>Amendment ("CMA") process</u>; and to further develop a comprehensive approach for notification and information for all County property owners concerning the proposed zoning classification changes.

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2018, the County Council of Prince George's County,
Maryland, sitting as the District Council, enacted legislation within the 2018 legislative year
known as CB-013-2018, CB-015-2018, and CB-065-2018; more specifically, a replacement
Zoning Ordinance, replacement Subdivision Regulations, and replacement County Landscape
Manual, respectively, set forth at Subtitle 27 and Subtitle 24 of the Prince George's County
Code; and

WHEREAS, in its enactment of CB-013-2018, CB-015-2018, and CB-065-2018, the
 Council recognized that the implementation of said replacement Zoning and Subdivision
 provisions necessitate approval of a <u>"CMA"</u>, so as to apply the zoning classifications
 contemplated in the replacement Zoning Ordinance to all parcels of land situated in that portion

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of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Council's enactment of CB-014-2018 on October 23, 2018, Part 19 of the Zoning Ordinance establishes certain procedures for preparation, publication, consideration, and approval of a comprehensive amendment of the County Zoning Map, as a non-substantive zoning reclassification of land located within all Planning Areas of the County; and

WHEREAS, the specific purposes of the CMA are set forth at law in Section 27-1900(a) of the Zoning Ordinance, as follows:

- To apply zoning categories contained in Prince George's County's new Zoning Ordinance to all real property in Prince George's County;
- (2) To provide for a comprehensive and systematic rezoning procedure that bridges the gap between the abrogation date of this Zoning Ordinance and the effective date of the new Zoning Ordinance;
- (3) To limit piecemeal rezoning;
- (4) To notify landowners, municipalities, special governed taxing districts, developers, civic associations, agencies, and other County stakeholders of the zoning changes impacting real property;
- (5) To provide the necessary foundation the new Zoning Ordinance requires before it can become effective;
- (6) To efficiently and effectively rezone all property in the County in all Planning Areas comprehensively and systematically, in a timely manner, and in accordance with all applicable State and local laws; and

WHEREAS, the approved Fiscal Year 2019 Planning Department Work Program includes preparation of a CMA for the non-substantive zoning reclassification of land located within all Planning Areas of the Maryland-Washington Regional District within Prince George's County, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, Section 27-1901(b) of the Zoning Ordinance requires the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, to approve an estimated CMA schedule; recommended Goals, Concepts, Guidelines; and Public Participation Program; and a staff decision matrix to guide recommendations during the preparation of a proposed

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CMA; in the initiation of the CMA; and

WHEREAS, the Goals, Concepts, and Guidelines; and Public Participation Program (Attachment A) build upon the specific purposes of the CMA, specify the parameters guiding the non-substantive zoning reclassification of land located within all Planning Areas of the Maryland-Washington Regional District within Prince George's County, Maryland, and outline the methodology for ensuring adequate community involvement in the CMA; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the District Council to expeditiously complete the preparation and approval of the CMA in order for the new Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Regulations to take effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission is hereby directed to prepare a Countywide Sectional Map Amendment for Prince George's County in accordance with the requirements of Part 19 of the Zoning Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Council has considered and hereby approves the recommended Goals, Concepts, and Guidelines; and Public Participation Program (Attachment A); and project schedule (Attachment B).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Council has considered and hereby approves the Guide to New Proposed Zones, being also and the same a staff decision matrix to guide recommendations during the preparation of a proposed CMA as required by Section 27-1901(b)(3) of the Zoning Ordinance (Attachment C).

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
