RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The 2010 Historic Sites and Districts Plan for Prince George's County – Minor Amendment
3 For the purpose of directing the Prince George's County Planning Board of the Maryland-
4 National Capital Park and Planning Commission to initiate a minor amendment to the 2010
5 *Historic Sites and Districts Plan*.

6 WHEREAS, on June 8, 2010, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the District
7 Council for that portion of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's
8 County ("District Council"), approved the *Prince George's County Historic Sites and Districts*
9 *Plan*; a functional master plan as defined in Section 27-107.01(a); and

10 WHEREAS, the 2010 *Prince George's County Historic Sites and Districts Plan* provides
11 that historic sites must meet specific criteria for historic, cultural, archeological and/or
12 architectural significance found in Subtitle 29-104 of the County Code; and

13 WHEREAS, the Old Marlboro Primary School, located at 14554 Elm Street, Upper
14 Marlboro, was designated as Historic Site 79-019-51 in the 2010 *Prince George's County*
15 *Historic Sites and Districts Plan*; and

16 WHEREAS, the Old Marlboro High School, located at 14524 Elm Street, Upper Marlboro,
17 was designated as Historic Site 79-019-52 in the 2010 *Prince George's County Historic Sites*
18 *and Districts Plan*; and

19 WHEREAS, the District Council finds that there is a need to reevaluate the designation of
20 Historic Sites 79-019-51 and 79-019-52 for removal from the 2010 *Prince George's County*
21 *Historic Sites and Districts Plan*; and
