Legislative Summary


CR-069-2019 establishes policies and procedures to govern the advertisement and solicitation of vacancies on County Boards and Commissions.

Background

Administrative appointments by the County Executive to a position on a board or commission shall be subject to confirmation by majority vote of the full County Council. The County Council shall hold public hearings on all such appointments not less than thirty days after their submission to the Council by the County Executive. If the Council fails to act to confirm or reject such appointments within forty-five days of their submission to the Council by the County Executive, the appointment shall stand approved.

Assumptions and Methodology

CR-069-2019 establishes policies and procedures to govern the advertisement and solicitation of vacancies on County Boards and Commissions. The Resolution also establishes criteria for the appointment of volunteers pursuant to Charter Section 322, or Council Rule 20.2, to serve on County Boards and Commissions and requires a description of each Board or Commission along with a list of vacancies to be posted online. The online postings may provide a centralized source of information to all residents regarding opportunities to serve and enhance government transparency.
