Committee Vote: Favorable with amendments, 4 – 0 (In favor: Hawkins, Ivy, Harrison and Taveras)

The Health, Human Services and Public Safety Committee met on September 18, 2019 to consider CR-73-2019 Draft 2. This resolution proposes to allow incorporated Prince George's County municipalities to have food trucks hubs within their jurisdiction. Currently, a special resolution is required in section 5-189.01 of the Prince George's County Code. The municipalities would have to communicate with DPIE about locations of hubs and designation of a coordinator. The authority to charge fees would have a cap of \$75.00.

The Food Truck Hub Oversight Committee Chair spoke in support of the legislation.

The Office of Law had not reviewed Draft 2 at the time of the meeting.

DPIE Director Melinda Boling expressed support for CR-73-2019 Draft 2, and stated that additional authority may need to be granted to DPIE to operate within municipalities.

The Office of Audits & Investigations Policy Analysis and Fiscal Impact Statement indicates that adoption of CR-73-2019 Draft 2, should not have a significant adverse fiscal impact on the County.
