WHEREAS, during the Fiscal Year 1994 Bi-County budget process the Montgomery and		
Prince George's County Councils established a Bi-County Working Group to recommend		
changes that wou	ald control the growth of debt and maintain future rate increases at WSSC close	
to the level of inf	flation; and	
WHEREAS, the Working Group's January 1994 Report recommended the establishment of		
a spending afford	lability process; and	
WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council endorsed the entire Working Group's		
report through the adoption of CR-12-1994 and the Montgomery County Council endorsed part		
of the report's recommendations through Resolution #12-1558; and		
WHEREAS, the Councils jointly endorsed in concept the January 1994 Working Group		
Report spending	affordability process; and	
WHEREAS, both Councils endorsed the utilization of the spending affordability process		
beginning with the	inning with the formulation of the Fiscal Year 1996 budget; and	
WHEREAS	S, the Spending Affordability Working Group, consisting of the staffs of the	
Montgomery and	Prince George's County Councils and both County Executive's offices, make	
certain recomme	ndations on the WSSC Fiscal Year 2021 Operating and Capital Budgets; and	
WHEREAS	S, the Prince George's County Council and the Montgomery County Council	

have reviewed the information compiled by the staff relating to spending control limits on the percentage of water and sewer increase; new debt; debt service and operating expenditures; and

WHEREAS, on October 24, 2019, the Transportation, Infrastructure, Energy and Environment Committee discussed the spending control limits for WSSC's FY 2021 Capital and Operating Budgets and voted on recommendations to the Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Council hereby endorses the following spending control limits for the Fiscal Year 2021 Water and Sewer Operating and Capital Budgets of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission:

Maximum Average Rate Increase:	7.0 %
New Water and Sewer Debt:	\$409,922,000
Water and Sewer Debt Service:	\$313,865,000
Total Water and Sewer Operating Expense:	\$837,660,000
