## **REPORT:**

The Health, Human Services and Public Safety Committee met on October 16, 2019 to consider the appointments of Kelvin D. Duvall, Llamilet Gutierrez, Esq., James T Rice, Marsha A. Ridley and Daniel C. Vergamini to the Citizen Complaint Oversight Panel (CCOP). The purpose of the CCOP is to evaluate investigations of police misconduct and to monitor the Prince George's County Police Department.

The County Executive's Appointments Liaison introduced the appointees and provided the committee with background information about each. The appointments liaison explained that Llamilet Gutierrez, Esq. has asked not to be considered and that James Rice would be unable to attend the meeting due to a preexisting commitment. The nominees then introduced themselves, provided brief introductory remarks and answered questions from the committee members.

After discussion, the Health, Human Services and Public Safety Committee, voted the appointments of the individuals named to the Citizen Complaint Oversight Panel out favorably, 4-0.
