The Council enacted CB-6-2016 on April 5, 2016, which amended swimming pool supervision requirements for hotels and motels in the County to coincide with State safety regulations. The proposed legislation will allow the safety standards for pools under 2,500 square feet of water in the County to apply to health club services pools.
