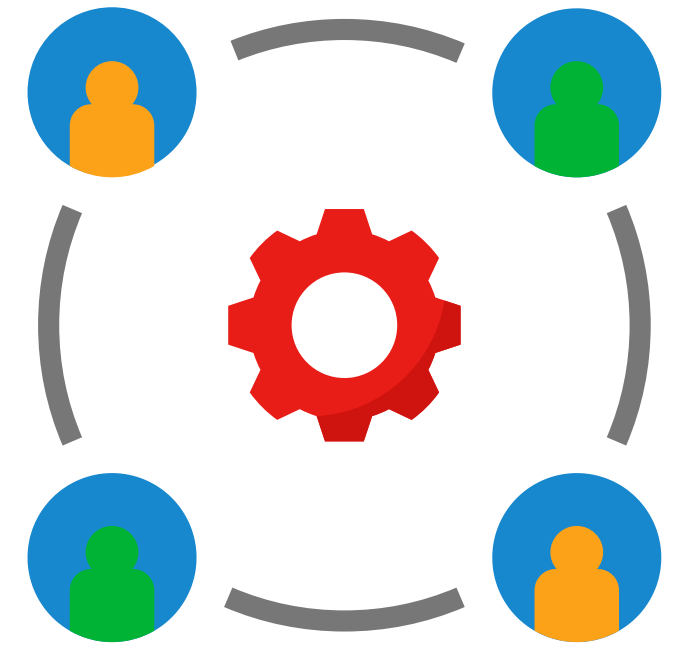

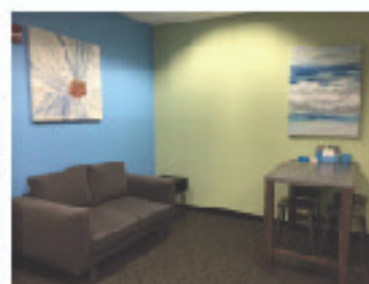
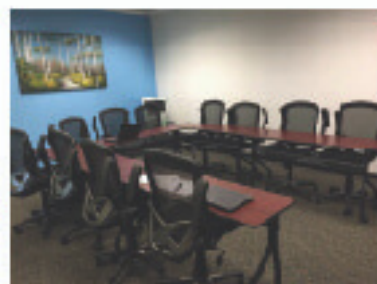

Mission and Vision

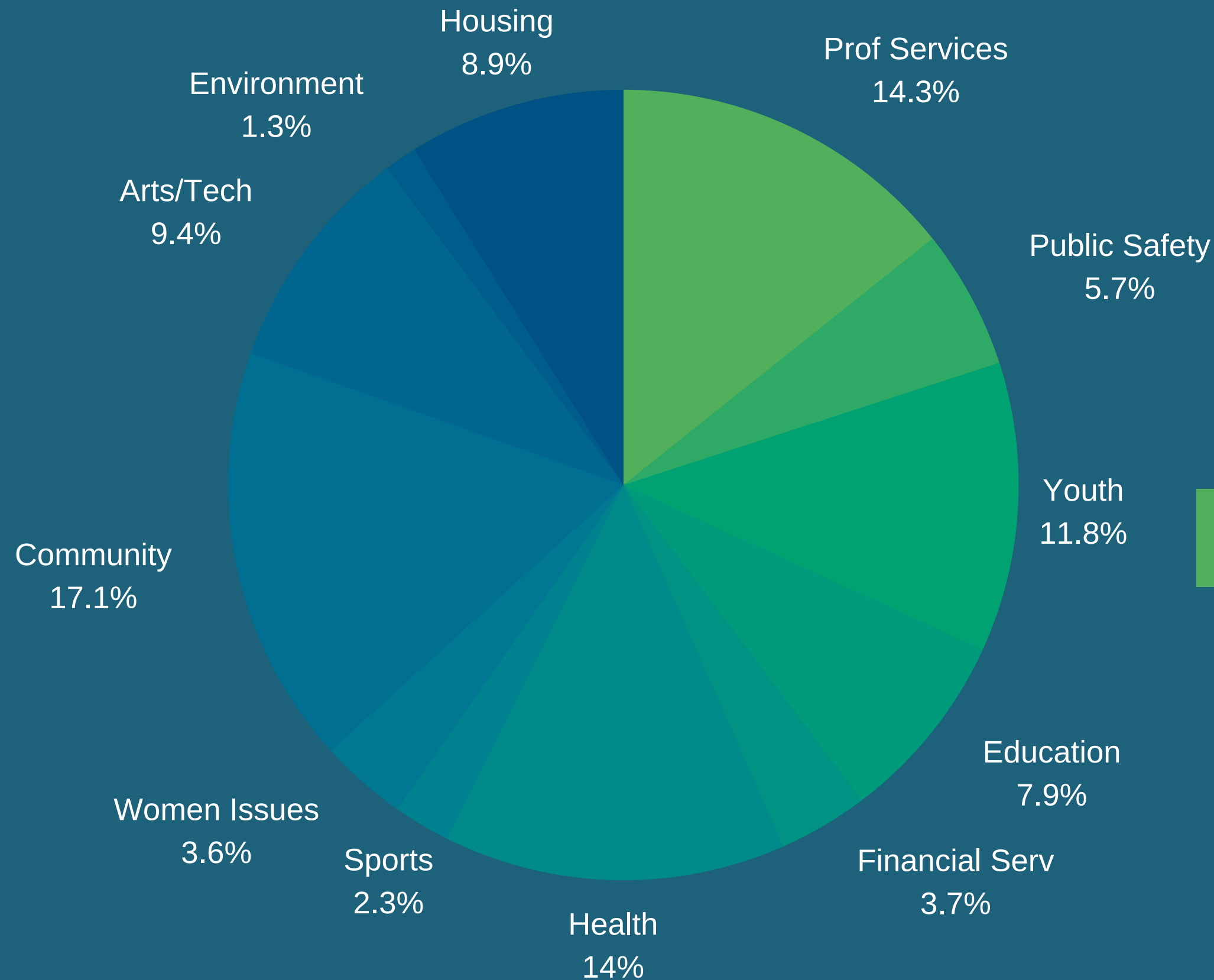
Our mission is to develop the nonprofit and minority business sector by providing assessment, support and expansion services.

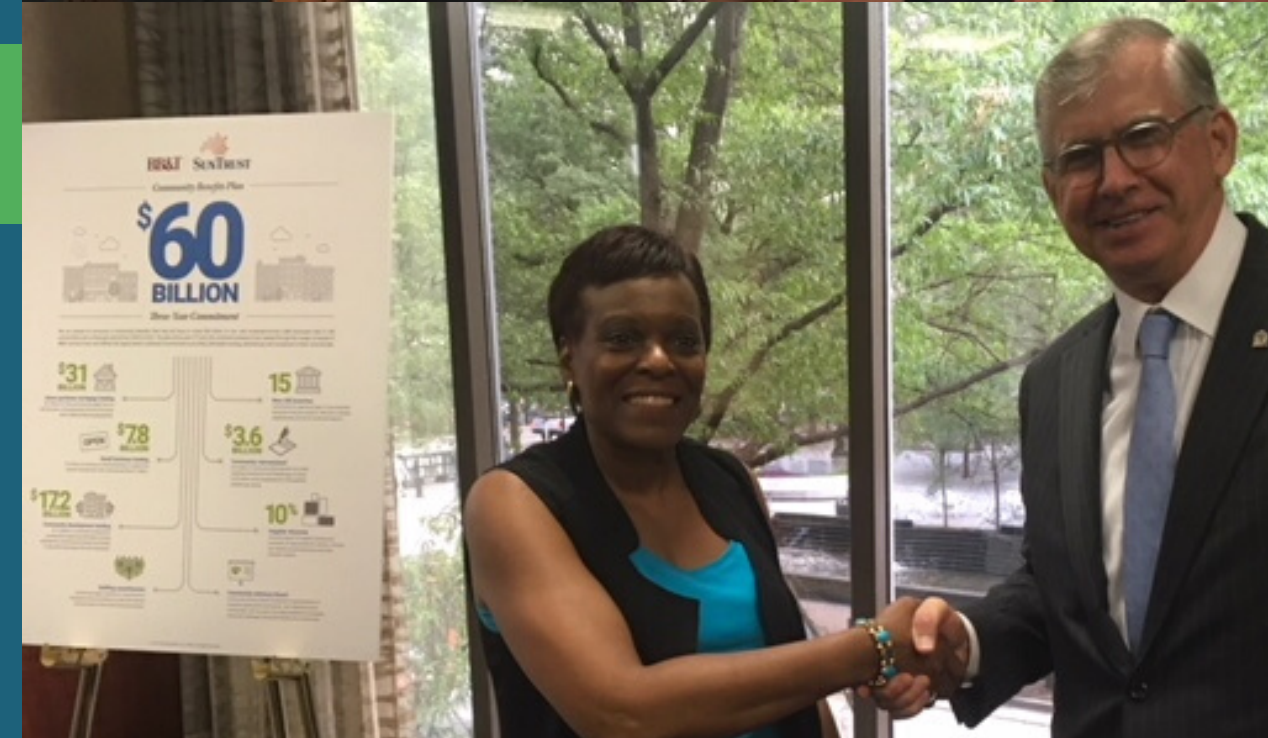
