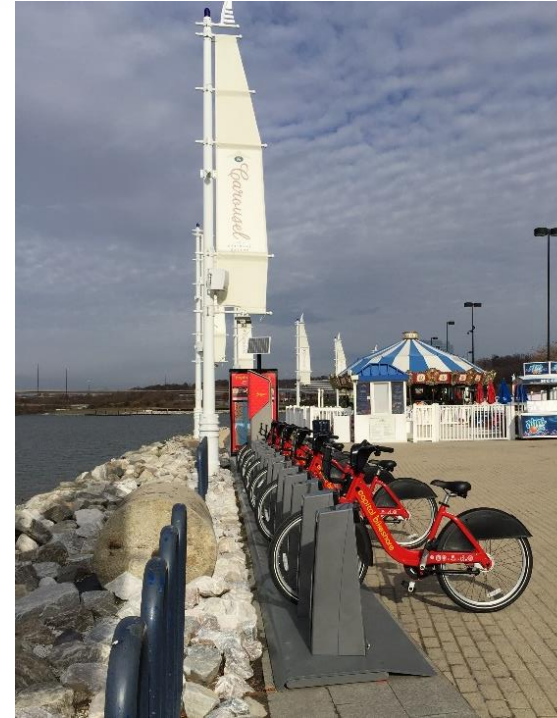

## Transportation, Infrastructure, Energy and Environment Committee

- There are 24 Capital Bikeshare Stations within Prince George's County.
- Over 550 stations throughout the Capital Bikeshare System in Maryland, Washington DC and Virginia.
- DPW&T installed a new 15 dock Capital Bikeshare Station at National Harbor Carousel - December 2019.
- Capital Bikeshare will launch Hybrid ebikes adding pedal-assist bicycles to the existing system – Spring 2020.
- *Capital Bikeshare For All* equity program – Spring 2020.

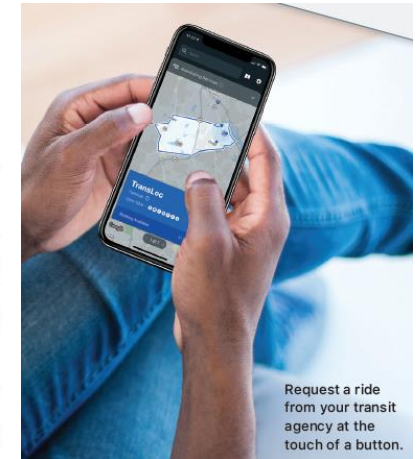
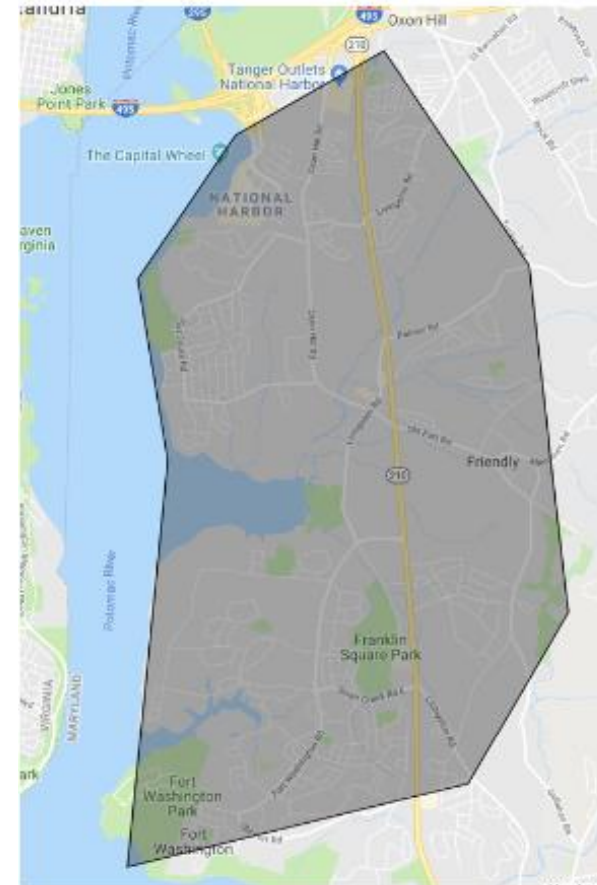
## BIKE TO WORK DAY 2020 Friday May 15

- Regional coordinated effort to promote biking as a form of work-based transportation.
- Friday, May 15, 2020, 7:00 AM – 9:00 AM.
- DPW&T and Prince George's Community College will co-host a Bike to Work Day Pit Stop at the Largo Campus.
- More information coming soon.



## Micro-transit is on demand, door-to-door service within a defined zone.

- Features App driven, automated dispatching.
  - Reservations can also be made by phone.
- Pilot zone – Fort Washington Area
  - Includes MGM, Old Fort Village, Top Golf, etc.
- Transit staff will evaluate performance to determine potential expansion.
- Anticipated Launch: Spring 2020.



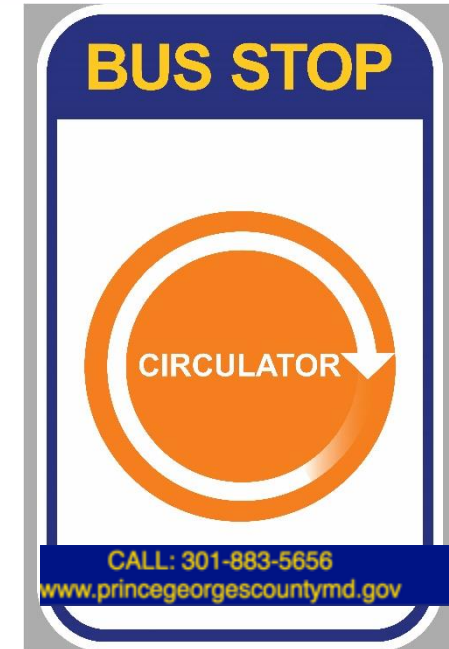


## South County Circulator

- Next month, DPW&T will launch a pilot circulator to connect residents of senior housing in Oxon Hill and Fort Washington to popular destinations in South County.
- Service Period: 10am to 4pm, M-W-F

## Call-A-Bus Next Day Reservations

- Call-A-Bus reservation requirements reduced from 7-days to next day service.
- Launch - Spring 2020



## Electric Buses

- DPW&T awarded \$2.2M from FTA for its first four environmentally friendly electric buses and related electric infrastructure.
- Anticipated bus delivery Winter 2021



## Saturday Service – The Bus

- For the first time, *TheBus* will operate on Saturdays.
- Pilot service from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm will begin on selected bus lines in Late Spring 2020.





# ENHANCED MOBILITY GRANT AWARD



## Pilot Goal: To address a recognized transportation need

- Prince George's County has the highest number of dialysis patients in the State of Maryland.
- Dialysis treatments tend to be **Monday, Wednesday, and Friday** or **Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday**
- DPW&T currently provides 200 Trips Weekly... but we do not run on Saturdays.
- Secured Grant Award of Approximately \$130,000.







## Medical Assistance Mobility Enhancement Pilot Program

- Eligible Participants – Currently transported dialysis patients.
- Taxicab Requirements– Regulation compliant, trained taxicab operators.
- Training – Will focus specifically on dialysis patient needs and concerns.
- Fares – **FREE** for patients. Drivers direct paid through App from program funds.
- Target Deployment – Late Spring/Early Summer.





## WMATA FY 21 BUDGET PROPOSAL

- The Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA) released its proposed fare increases, service changes and cuts to Metrobus service in Prince George's County.
- DPW&T recently met with representatives of Montgomery County and MDOT to discuss the proposed FY21 WMATA budget.
