WHEREAS	the global pandemic Coronavirus ("COVID-19") continues to pose an
imminent risk to t	he health, safety and welfare of Prince George's County residents; and
WHEREAS	emergency declarations issued at the federal, State and County level remain in
effect; and	
WHEREAS	COVID-19 continues to present economic and personnel challenges for the
County; and	
WHEREAS	the County Executive has recommended that the Salary Plan be amended to
reflect the additio	n of COVID-19 Hazard Pay for employees covered by Salary Schedule P-O;
and	
WHEREAS	pursuant to Section 903 of Article IX of the Prince George's County Charter
and Section 16-12	25(a) of the Prince George's County Code, amendments to the County's Salary
Plans are to be su	bmitted to the County Council in resolution form; and
WHEREAS	Salary Schedule P-O, covering the period July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2020,
was adopted by th	ne County Council on October 23, 2018 with the passage of CR-67-2018; and
WHEREAS, the Salary Plan needs to be amended to reflect the requested modifications	
from the County l	Executive.
NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
County, Maryland, that an amendment to Salary Schedule P-O submitted and recommended by	

1 the County Executive on April 29, 2020, as set forth below and that adds Section 32, be and the 2 same is hereby approved: 3 Add New Section 32 to Salary Schedule P-O, which shall read as follows: 4 32. COVID-19 HAZARD PAY 5 A. As we continue to address the COVID-19 pandemic, employees covered by Salary Schedule P-O are entitled to receive a stipend in the amount of \$350.00 per pay period. 6 7 The stipend will be called the *COVID-19 Hazard Pay*. For an employee to receive the 8 COVID-19 Hazard Pay, an employee must work 75% of their scheduled hours. If an 9 employee works less than 75% of their scheduled hours, the COVID-19 Hazard Pay 10 shall be prorated accordingly. B. The COVID-19 Hazard Pay will start with the pay period beginning April 5, 2020, and 11 will continue until the County declaration of emergency is terminated, or June 28, 12 13 2020, whichever is earlier. 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect on the day it is 15 adopted and shall be retroactively effective to April 5, 2020.
