BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

The 2018 Water and Sewer Plan provides for four cycles of category change requests annually to amend the Plan. This Resolution represents the January 2020 Cycle of Amendments.

The 2018 Water and Sewer Plan was adopted by CR-64-2019, and amended by CR-75-2019.

There is one (1) category change requested in the Piscataway sewer basin; the Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement has modified maps of residential properties to reflect the existing sewer service category; and, there are text revisions to Chapter 6, *Appendix 6-1, and Appendix 6-2*.

Environment Article, Title 9, Subtitle 5, of the Maryland Annotated Code, sets procedures for amendments and revisions to the Plan. At least 30 days prior to the public hearing on the amendments, the County Council must submit to the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission and Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission a copy of the resolution for their recommendations.
