As part of the efforts to address a wide variety of needs including providing shelter to homeless individuals, increasing affordable housing options, and

maintaining crucial public services during the current public health outbreak (COVID-19), Congress designated funding to federal entitlement programs, allocated through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"). Specifically, Prince George's County is designated to receive funding totaling approximately \$4,560,861, including \$3,036,958 in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and \$1,523,903 for the Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) program. This Resolution requires at least one (1) public hearing because the proposed amendment to the FY 2020 Annual Action Plan would constitute a "substantial change" under the FY 2016-2020 County Citizen Participation Plan, as described in the County's FY 2016-2020 Consolidated Plan.
