# **BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:**

CR-81-2019 was adopted by the County Council on October 22, 2019 for the purpose of establishing the Prince George's County Responsible Legacy Task Force. The Task Force was responsible for reviewing all County monuments, schools, parks, street names, county buildings and other places of honor, and creating a process to determine the future of names linked to a prejudiced past. The proposed Legislation will revise the composition of the Task Force from eight members to nine members and extend the original date of September 14, 2020 to on or before December 01, 2020.
