BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This resolution seeks the approval of the County Council in order to fully exempt the Northgate Project from the school facilities surcharge, in accordance with Section 10-192.01 of the Prince George's County Code that enables the County Council to exempt some or all of the school facilities surcharge for undergraduate student housing within a designated geographical area located in the City of College Park. The project includes 296 units of student housing, 1,084 square feet of commercial retail space and structured parking with 300 spaces.
