WHEREAS, the Administrator of the MTA is authorized to make grants to counties and		
local governments for public transportation projects in small urbanized and rural areas, as well		
as, for specialize	transportation projects statewide; and	
WHEREAS	an application for financial assistance imposes certain obligations upon the	
applicant, which	ncludes a local share of the costs for certain projects and/or programs; and	
WHEREAS	the United States Department of Transportation, in accordance with the	
provisions of Tit	VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, requires an application for assistance	
under the Federa	Transit Act to give assurance that it will comply with the Title VI of the Civil	
Rights Act of 19	4 and the United States Department of Transportation requirements thereunder	
and		

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Department of Public Works and Transportation

(DPW&T) has submitted applications to the FTA for financial assistance under Section 5339 for the Low-No Program; and

WHEREAS, DPW&T has submitted applications to the MDOT-MTA for financial assistance from the following state funding programs: (1) Section 5311 Funds; (2) the Large Urban Program State Funds; and (3) the ADA Operating Fund; and

WHEREAS, the County aims to utilize minority business enterprises to the fullest extent possible in connection with the programs and/or projects listed in the County's applications and shall establish and administer procedures to ensure that minority businesses have the maximum construction, supplies, equipment, consultant and other service contracts; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of awarding federal and state transportation funding through the ATP, PTP and ADA, the FTA and MTA require the governing body of Prince George's County, by resolution, to authorize the filing of the aforesaid applications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the filing of the aforesaid applications for Fiscal Year 2021 be endorsed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Prince George's County Executive is hereby requesting to endorse this Resolution, thereby indicating approval thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution shall be sent to the Maryland Transit Administration of the Maryland Department of Transportation.
