RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Car Free Day 2020

3 For the purpose of inviting the residents of Prince George's County to telework and try
 4 alternative forms of transportation such as transit, bicycling, and walking in a safe and healthy
 5 manner, on September 22, 2020, Car Free Day.

6 WHEREAS, the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB) is the
 7 metropolitan planning organization for the Washington, D.C. region; and

8 WHEREAS, the TPB through its Commuter Connections program organizes and promotes
 9 the annual Car Free Day event along with its jurisdictional network members throughout the
 10 region; and

11 WHEREAS, on July 22, 2020, the TPB approved a proclamation establishing Tuesday,
 12 September 22, 2020 as Car Free Day in the metropolitan Washington, D.C. area and encouraged
 13 TPB member jurisdictions to adopt similar resolutions; and

14 WHEREAS, Car Free Day benefits the National Capital Region through improved air
 15 quality, mobility, and energy conservation, and reduced parking demands; and

16 WHEREAS, Car Free Day corresponds with European Mobility Week, occurring
 17 September 16-22, 2020 celebrating sustainable mobility.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
 19 County, Maryland, that Prince George's County joins the other jurisdictions of the National
 20 Capital Region by proclaiming Tuesday, September 22, 2020 as Car Free Day and invites the
 21 residents of Prince George's County to telework and try alternative forms of transportation such
 22 as transit, bicycling, and walking in a safe and healthy manner. Additional information regarding
