| 15 | SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,                   |   |  |  |  |

set forth therein:

(1) Conclusive evidence of the text of the Prince George's County Code and all enactments dated on or before November 30, 2019.

(2) Prima facie evidence of:

(A) The Prince George's County Charter, together with all amendments, and the Schedule of Legislation accompanying the Charter.

(B) Article 17 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland as enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland.

(C) All other County acts, ordinances, Code provisions, resolutions having the force of law, and all other legislation enacted or adopted after November 30, 2019.

(b) Supplements to the Prince George's County Code, 2019 Edition, shall be published annually.

(c) The words "County Code" or "Code" shall be taken to mean the Prince George's County Code, 2019 Edition, together with any current Supplement, unless the content clearly requires otherwise.

(d) The 2019 Edition of the Code supersedes previous editions thereof.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the 2019 Edition of the Prince George's County Code shall take effect on the effective date of this Act. The master copy of the 2019 Edition of the Code shall be authenticated by the Council's Legislative Officers and delivered as a public record to the Clerk of the Council. The Clerk shall maintain that master copy together with any Supplements thereto. A copy of the 2019 Edition of the Code shall be available at the Office of the Clerk of the Council for public use during regular business hours.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the Council's Legislative Officers are authorized to make appropriate editorial amendments and corrections to sections contained in Subtitle 4. Building to remove conflicts between references to the Building Code of the County.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the general penalty provided in Section 1-123 of the County Code shall apply to every offense or violation made unlawful by the County Code unless a specific penalty therefor is otherwise provided by law.

SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
