BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This resolution seeks the approval of the County Council in order to partially waive the Atworth Project from the public safety facilities surcharge, in accordance with Section 10-192.11(b)(3) of the Prince George's County Code that enables the County Council to waive the public safety facilities surcharge for certain multi-family housing projects. The project includes 451 market-rate multi-family dwelling units, 324 structured parking spaces, 79 surface parking spaces and 5,000 square feet of ground-floor retail space. Estimated construction is \$123.3 million.
