The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on October 15, 2020 to consider CR-089-2020. As proposed CR-089-2020 will appropriate funding from grants in the amount of \$410,254.55 for FY 2021. This appropriation will include funding for new or continuing grant programs in the Office of the State's Attorney, Department of Family Services, Department of Housing and Community Development and the Health Department. This new funding also includes \$81,989.00 of grant resources dedicated to support the County's Covid-19 response.

The Office of Law reports CR-089-2020 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The Policy Analyst group reports that the adoption of CR-089-2020 will have a positive fiscal impact on the County's FY'21 budget by appropriating an additional \$404,004.55 in outside sources. The grant awards require a cash match of \$6,250.00.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted CR-089-2020 favorably, 11-0.
