**RESOLUTION**

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Prince George's County Re-Entry Advisory Board

3 For the purpose of extending the reporting dates for the Prince George's County Re-Entry  
4 Advisory Board to make recommendations and submit preliminary and final reports.

5 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council on July 23, 2019 adopted CR-49-2019,  
6 establishing the Prince George's County Re-Entry Advisory Board (the "Board"), a twenty-one  
7 (21) member Board to determine, evaluate, assess and assist County agencies in implementing a  
8 comprehensive Re-Entry Program and re-entry services in the County; evaluate what resources  
9 will be needed to implement a comprehensive Re-Entry Program and re-entry services that  
10 clearly define and identify existing and implementable services offered within the County that  
11 address but are not limited to, employment, housing, mental health, and faith-based initiatives;  
12 form direction and provide assistance towards the implementation of programs and services in  
13 order to increase access and obtainment of employment, housing, mental health, and faith-based  
14 opportunities for re-entry citizens within the County; and develop a model program or systematic  
15 processes for serving formerly incarcerated persons pre and post incarceration release on or  
16 before November 1, 2020; and

17 WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic and pursuant to CR-10-2020, all scheduled  
18 public meetings of County Council Task Forces and Work Groups were postponed effective  
19 March 17, 2020; and

20 WHEREAS, the County Council desires to provide additional time to the Board to ensure  
21 that the Board has the time it needs to meet and process the significant amount of information it  
22 has gathered; and

1 WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the County Council may appoint, for  
2 designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the County who shall  
3 assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's  
5 County, Maryland, that the Board's original preliminary report deadline is extended for  
6 submission on or before June 15, 2021 and the original final report deadline is extended for  
7 submission on or before November 1, 2021.
