The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on October 29, 2020 to consider the appointment (APPT-13-20) of Llamilet Gutierrez, Esq. to the Human Relations Commission. The Human Relations Commission works to eliminate discriminatory practices within the County, through advocacy, education, mediation and investigation of complaints and enforcement of discrimination laws.

Ms. Gutierrez is a resident of Riverdale and is the Executive Director of The Amara Legal Center. She manages the day to day operations and oversees the internship, pro-bono, legal services and policy programs. Previously, Ms. Gutierrez served in the Office of the Maryland Public Defender.

Ms. Gutierrez is a member of the Prince George's County Bar Association, Maryland Hispanic Bar Association, and the National Hispanic Bar Association. She holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree from Dickinson College and a Juris Doctor Degree from Lewis and Clark Law School.

During the meeting, Council Members lauded the County Executive for such an outstanding appointment.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted the Human Relations Commission appointment out favorably, 10-0.
