The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on 10/29/2020 to consider appointments the of Ms. Amber L. Woods and the reappointments of Ms. Veronica L. Davila-Steele and Mr. Eugene A. "Tony" Langbehn as members of the Commission for Individuals with Disabilities for Prince George's County which seeks to works with stakeholders to jointly address and promote the needs and rights of individuals with disabilities.

Ms. Amber L. Woods, a resident of Fort Washington, is an advocate for individuals with disabilities. Most recently, she was a Contractor Closeout Contract Specialist for the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) through Columbia Lighthouse for the Blind. Ms. Woods is currently President of the National Harbor Chapter, National Federation of the Blind of Maryland in addition to being named Vice President of Living Independently for Everyone Inc. Ms. Veronica L. Davila-Steele, a resident of Oxon Hill, has served on the Commission since 2018 as a consumer member.

Mr. Eugene A. "Tony" Langbehn, a resident of Bowie, will continue to serve as a consumer member, since his original appointment in 2007.

After discussion about the Commission for Individuals with Disabilities, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole voted APPT-15-20 out favorable, 10-0.
