For the purpose of designating Teed House (Documented Property 60-037-50) as a Prince			
George's County historic site.			
WHEREAS, Section 29-120.01 of the Prince George's County Code provides a process for			
the owner(s) of an historic property to petition for designation as an historic site with the Prince			
George's County Historic Preservation Commission; and			
WHEREAS, the Teed House, located at 4505 Beechwood Road, College Park, is significant			
as a substantially intact example of Tudor Revival domestic architecture and as one of the first			
houses to be constructed by the College Park Corporation in the Calvert Hills section of College			
Park, the Teed House and its 0.221-acre Environmental Setting meets HPC Historic Site			
designation criteria (1)(A)(iv), (2)(A)(i), and (2)(A)(v), and therefore could be designated as a			
Historic Site and included in the Inventory of Historic Sites; and			
WHEREAS, this property is a representative example of its type, period of construction,			
and location; and			
WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Sec. 29-120.01, the property owners,			
Kenneth W. Porter and Angela G. Porter, filed a petition with the Historic Preservation			
Commission for designation of their property as a historic site; and			
WHEREAS, after proper posting and notice was given as required by law, the Prince			
George's County Historic Preservation Commission held a public hearing on April 21, 2020; and			
WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission recommended that the Teed House			

(Documented Property 66-037-50) and its 0.221-acre Environmental Setting (East 20 feet of Lot 90 and west 50 feet of Lot 91 in Block F, College Park Section A) be designated as a historic site based on the designation criteria described above; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the District Council, held a joint public hearing on the significance of this property with the Prince George's County Planning Board on July 14, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the record of the hearing was left open until 5:00 p.m. on July 21, 2020; and no additional material was received, and

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2020, the Prince George's County Planning Board voted to recommend that the Teed House be designated as a historic site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Teed House (Documented Property 66-037-50) and its 0.221-acre Environmental Setting (East 20 feet of Lot 90 and west 50 feet of Lot 91 in Block F, College Park Section A) is hereby designated as a Prince George's County historic site.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Clerk of the Council be directed to mail copies of this Resolution to the Prince George's County Historic Preservation Commission, the Prince George's Planning Board, and Stephen and Angela Porter.
