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**REPORT:** Favorable 10-0: Council Members Turner, Anderson-Walker, Dernoga, Franklin, Glaros, Harrison, Hawkins, Ivey, Streeter and Taveras. Absent: Davis

The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on November 12, 2020 to consider CR-106-2020. As proposed CR-106-2020 will appropriate grants from Federal, State and other sources in the amount of \$6,105,099.00 in the FY21 budget. Submitted pursuant to Section 815 of the County Charter, these funds will go to Non-Departmental.

According to David Iannaucchi, President and CEO, Economic Development Corporation, these funds will be used to assist the hospitality and restaurant industry in Prince George's County. Mr. Iannaucchi provided a brief overview of how this program will work.

The Office of Law reports CR-106-2020 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted CR-106-2020 out favorably, 10-0.
