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**REPORT:** Favorable 10-0: Council Members Turner, Anderson-Walker, Dernoga, Franklin, Glaros, Harrison, Hawkins, Ivey, Streeter and Taveras. Absent: Davis

The Prince George's County Council convened in the Committee of the Whole on November 12, 2020 to consider CR-108-2020.

As proposed CR-108-2020 will amend the salary plan for the Prince George's Correctional Officers' Association, Inc. (Correctional Officers), Salary Schedule D. This Salary Plan amendment provides for Covid-19 Hazard Pay for the period of August 1, 2020 through September 26, 2020. The resolution will also temporarily increase the maximum annual leave carryover hours from 2020 into annual leave year 2021, from 360 hours to 440 hours. Unless amended by future legislation, the maximum amount that may be carried over from leave year 2021 into 2022 shall revert back to 360 hours. This modified benefit shall sunset automatically upon its implementation.

Stanley Earley, Director, Office of Management and Budget provided an explanation of the leave carry over.

The fiscal impact of CR-108-2020 is \$894,600.00. Funds will come from Federal Covid-19 monies. The County will fund the leave carry-over cost.

The Office of Law finds CR-108-2020 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted CR-108-2020 out favorably, 10-0.
